

**GRADUATE CREDIT FROM NORTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY
REGISTRATION INFORMATION
JAZZ AT LINCOLN CENTER BAND DIRECTOR ACADEMY**

Northern Illinois University is offering two credit hours of graduate credit for qualified students enrolled in Jazz at Lincoln Center's **Band Director Academy** in Summer 2010. The supervising faculty member is Ron Carter, professor, NIU School of Music and Director, Jazz at Lincoln Center Band Director Academy. Participants who are interested in enrolling in the workshop for credit will be expected to fulfill requirements as outlined by Professor Carter.

To enroll in a class for graduate credit, a student must have an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning and: (1) be admitted to the NIU Graduate School; or (2) apply for and obtain permission from the NIU Graduate School for Student-at-Large status:

New students may apply on-line or by mail to become an NIU student. Graduate applications are at www.grad.niu.edu/apply/index.shtml. Once an application is in the system, a student is assigned a Z number; this allows them to track their application and gives access to MyNIU.

After a student is admitted, registration information is available through MyNIU at www.niu.edu/myniu/. To access MyNIU, first follow the link and log on using your Z number. Once in MyNIU, click "Self-Service" then "Student Center" to view many useful links including a class browser and registration links.

All students must register for credit *no later than* the end of the first day, but it is recommended that the process be started earlier to avoid problems. June 25 is both the add and drop deadline for this class.

Tuition: Students pay the cost of tuition for two credit hours of graduate credit, which is \$735 for Illinois residents and \$1,283 for those who do not live in Illinois; this includes the cost of fees. Note: Graduate credit tuition paid to NIU is optional and separate from the required Band Director Academy tuition paid to Jazz at Lincoln Center.
